The US Army Aeromedical Research Laboratory (USAARL) is conducting a study to determine the effects of wearing helmet and helmet-mounted devices on potential neck injury risk.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Males and Females between the ages of 18 and 60
- Active duty, national guard, or reserve status
- No current shoulder or neck injury
- No prolonged or substantial exposure to vibration from rotary-wing aircraft

Compensation:

May receive \$35 upon completion of study.

*Note – you must be on leave or non-duty status to receive compensation

You Will Be Asked To:

- Test neck strength and range of motion
- Complete surveys regarding neck pain, neck injury, and helmet wear
